

## Process for 121's

WOOOOHOOOO! We are back in business training at Bowerland! We are able to start teaching limited 121s at Devon Dogs. Please take a look at our current and ever changing guidelines below:

### Pre-Arrival

- Please come straight to Devon Dogs from home, if you need to stop for any supplies, we ask you to do so after your lesson to minimize contact with people prior to your arrival at Devon Dogs.
- Please pack all the equipment you will need: raised bed, water, water bowl, training food, harnesses, leads, long line, crate, coffee/tea, poo bags etc. We will not be able to lend you any equipment.
- Please pack hand sanitizer for use upon arrival.
- Ensure you have used the toilet yourself prior to arriving at Devon Dogs as toilet facilities are not available in the field where training will take place right now. We are using open outdoor spaces to adhere with government guidelines.
- Please pack wet weather gear, sun hat, shade for your vehicle. We will work outdoors for all training sessions whatever the weather right now.

### Arrival

- Please remain in your vehicle until your trainer indicates they are ready for you.
- A 2 metre distance between you and your trainer will be enforced.
- Your trainer will not handle any of your equipment or have any physical contact with your dog or you.
- Please sanitise your hands with your hand sanitizer prior to exiting your vehicle.
- Do not touch any of the Devon Dogs equipment, your trainer will move all equipment for your lesson.
- We appreciate you not letting your dog jump on the trainers.

### Exciting!

- Please ensure you take all of your belongings.
- We kindly ask that you leave the premises promptly so that there is no cross over with lessons on the training field.
- Please take your poo bags with you and dispose of these appropriately. We cannot dispose of any additional waste on site and need to minimise areas where multiple people touch.
